Before production of any order, we need to have an approved printed sample on record as well as approval on final layout of the design.

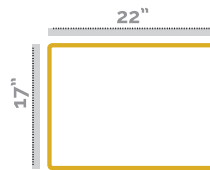
NEXT WE PRODUCE YOUR SAMPLE

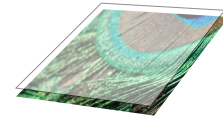

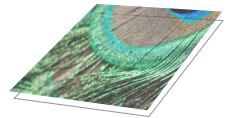

FINAL TOUCHES

We will work with you to coordinate the details affecting the final design, such as color matching and dimensions of your Imagitect installation location.



Color Matching

We will calibrate and blend for specific Pantone and paint brands, allowing you to see how your colors appear on Imagitect.



Final Dimensions
